<b>9.1</b>	<b>Purpose:</b>
9.1.1	To define the ACCAB accreditation requirements.
<b>9.2</b>	<b>Scope:</b>
9.2.1	Applicable to all the Conformity Assessment Bodies (CABs) Accreditation Schemes/Programs operated by the ACCAB.
<b>9.3</b>	<b>Responsibility &amp; Authority:</b>
9.3.1	The Chief Executive Officer is responsible for communicating and overseeing this procedure and the top management of the applicant and accredited CABs is responsible for ensuring that the requirements are fully met.
<b>9.4</b>	<b>Operation:</b>
9.4.1	Compliance with Legal Requirements:
9.4.2	The CAB shall be a legal entity, such that it can be held legally responsible for all its conformity assessment activities.
9.4.3	The CAB shall comply with all the applicable legal requirements in the countries in which they operate.
9.4.4	The CAB shall Endeavour to protect the intellectual property of ACCAB, ISO, and any other Standardization Organization.
9.4.5	The CAB shall have policy that appropriate key personnel have demonstrable understanding of applicable legal and statutory requirements.
9.4.6	The CAB's shall declare in the application for accreditation that whether or not there exists current legal processes or allegations concerning the compliance of the CAB with such legal and statutory requirements and should the CAB become aware at any time following accreditation being granted that legal proceedings have been initiated or other allegations concerning the legal compliance of the CAB arise, they shall notify the ACCAB as soon as it is practicable and within a maximum of seven days, and shall advise the ACCAB of the outcome of any such proceedings and the statement shall be signed by the top management.
9.4.7	The CAB's shall declare in the application for accreditation that that they have informed ACCAB of any matter that may be deemed significant when adjudicating the application, should it come to the light at a later date.
9.4.2	Compliance with the Relevant International Standards and ACCAB Requirements:
9.4.2.1	The ACCAB requires that the CAB have a publicly available policy which shall declare their stated and implied support for the mission and the objectives of the ACCAB, and shall ensure that they act in accordance with that policy always. If the ACCAB considers that a CAB undertakes work that is in a

	direct conflict to the ACCAB's mission and objectives it could lead to accreditation being withheld, suspended or withdrawn.

ISO 15189:2012 Medical laboratories -- Particular requirements for the quality and the competence.</li> <li>g.
